

How Do You Create a New Color?

ART, COMPETENCIES

Get ready

Prepare the classroom for painting - cover benches with plastic sheeting or paper.

Prepare postcards or photos of landscapes that are interesting in terms of color - e.g. cut them out of magazines (see Photographes - examples): 1 for each student.

GET GOING

Creative expression: Mixing colors + Recreating the colors of nature

- We provide:** Photographs (you can print them or just use as the examples)
- We provide:** Worksheet - colors (pdf)

For each team:

- plastic sheeting/drop cloth or waste paper for covering tables when painting
- cups with water
- paints - a set consisting of the following colors: red, blue, yellow and white
- scratch (scrap) paper or disposable paper plate
- postcards or photos of landscapes that are interesting in terms of color; cut out from magazines; at least 1 for each team
- brushes or spatulas and sponge (ideally for every student)

For each student:

- blank sheets of paper

GET PRACTICING

Creative expression: Students superimpose color onto a painting

- We provide:** worksheets (2 for a pair of students)
- additional colors (black and white)
- crayons (optional)
